SELF INTRODUCTION ACTIVITY

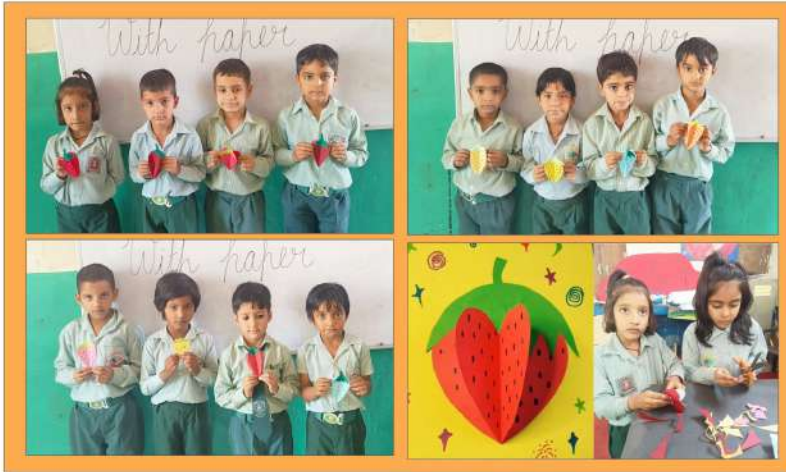

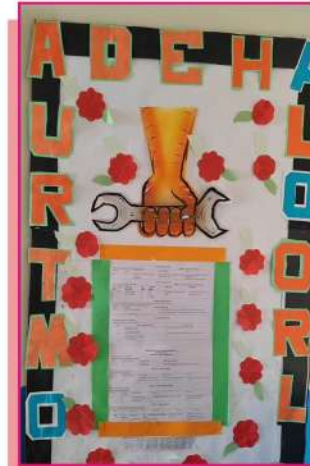

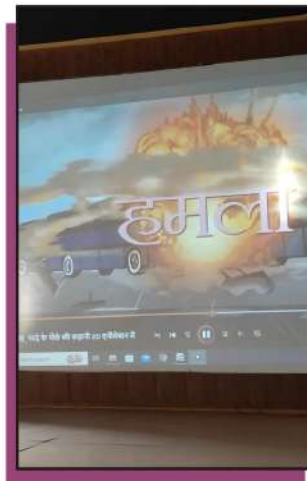
