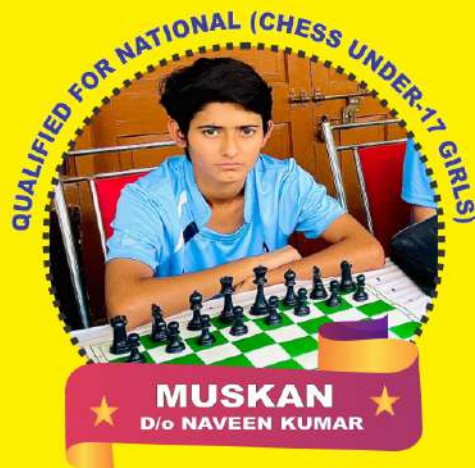

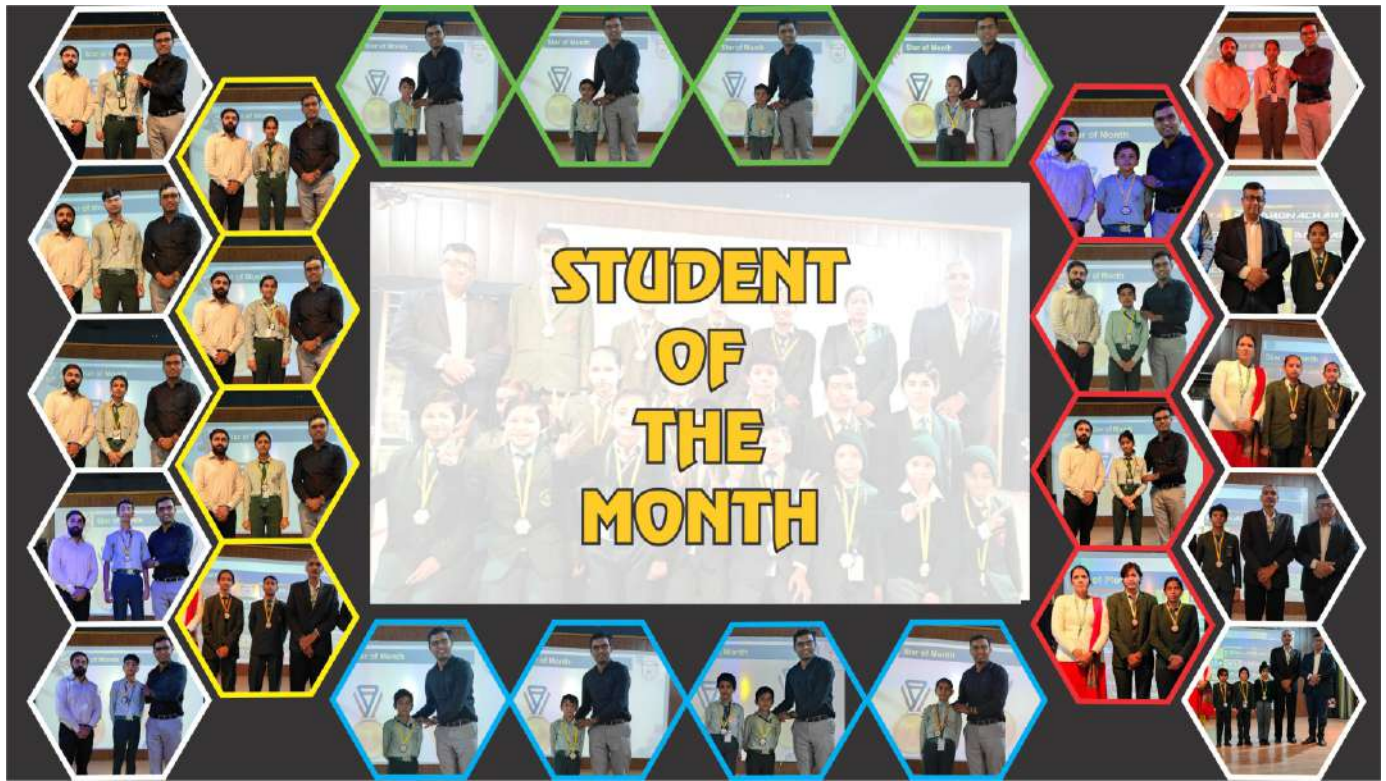

As we step into a season filled with festivities and exams, maintaining good physical and mental health is crucial. Here are some wellness tips to help students and families thrive:

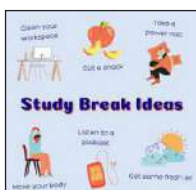
